

2023 Schedule of Dues and Fees

All dues and fees are subject to increase without notice. Dues and non-refundable membership fees are subject to 6.5% FL sales tax.

Full Golf Membership

2023 Dues \$11,227.83

\$55,000* (Non-Refundable Initiation Fee)

Full Members are entitled to full use of the club and its facilities. Full Members have a seven day sign-up privilege to reserve golf tee times and five days to reserve tennis courts. Full Members shall not pay green fees or court fees, but shall pay golf cart & guest fees.

Sports Membership

2023 Dues \$6,565.65

\$7,500 (Non-Refundable Initiation Fee)

Sports Member privileges will include use of the dining, pool, tennis, fitness and social facilities of the Club. Sports Members will also have the following golf privileges:

November 1st thru April 30th: Sports Members are allowed twelve (12) tee times during this 6 month period upon payment of daily sports green fees and cart fees. If a sports member is a guest of a golf member it is counted toward one of their (12) tee times. The driving range and practice facilities will be available to Sports Members on the days they have a scheduled tee time and after 1 p.m. on days without a tee time. Tee times may be made up to two days in advance during season.

May 1st – October 31st: Sports Members will have unlimited golf privileges upon payment of cart fee only. This includes the driving range and all practice facilities. Tee times may be made up to five days in advance during the off-season.

Club Membership

Club Member privileges will include use of the dining, pool, tennis, fitness and social facilities of the club. Each Club Membership is allowed to play six (6) rounds per calendar year as a guest of a Golf or Sport Member.

Social Membership

2023 Dues \$4092.82

\$1,500 (Non-Refundable Initiation Fee)

Social Member privileges will include use of the dining, social facilities and swimming pool at the club.

This membership is mandatory for all Grandezza residents who do not have higher category of membership.

The Club at Grandezza has adopted the following guidelines regarding dress in the various areas of the club. We also encourage members of Grandezza to enforce the Dress Code with other Grandezza Members.

Golf Course & Practice Facilities Dress Code

Collared shirts with sleeves for men, and/or a mock styled golf shirt Collarless fashion shirts are acceptable for ladies Sleeveless collared shirts are acceptable for ladies All men's shirts shall be tucked in Hats and visors shall be worn forward Shorts shall be no higher than 5 inches above the knee

The following is not permitted on the Golf Course & Practice Facilities

No walking the course/ Golf Carts only (No walking the course in evenings)
No cut-offs, cargo pants or cargo shorts
No tee shirts
No gym, walking, or tennis attire
No denim of any type
No pets allowed on the golf courts (Unless you have a Service Dog)

Clubhouse Dining Room, Hub Bar and Bogey's Dress Code

Collared shirts with sleeves for men/or a mock styled golf shirt
Collarless fashion shirts and or sleeveless collared shirts are acceptable for ladies
All men's shirts shall be tucked in
Shorts shall be no higher than 5 inches above the knee
No hats or visors allowed
Fashionable Jeans are allowed, with no holes or tears in them

The following is not permitted in The Clubhouse Dining Rooms, Hub Bar and Bogey's

No wet or soiled clothing/No swim suit attire

Men and boys are not permitted to wear hats while seated in the Dining Room

Gym shorts (Only downstairs, walking to and from the fitness Center)

Gym shorts are not permitted while in The Players' Lounge during coffee hour

Collarless shirts for men or boys

Tank tops/tee shirts/bare midriffs

Overalls, cutoffs, frayed edges, no holes, loose denim, or visible undergarments

Sweatpants and sweatshirts

Swimming attire may only be worn in the pool areas. (Please do not enter the Clubhouse in Pool Attire)

Please wear appropriate swimming attire. We are a family oriented club and would not want to offend any of our members/guests.

Infants/toddlers must wear the appropriate swim diaper under their swimming suit

Swim suits must cover the female appropriately

Swimming trunks must cover the men appropriately

Appropriate cover ups while sitting at the Cabana

Please do not come up to the Dining Room in swimsuit attire or cover ups

Tennis Dress Code

Proper tennis attire of shirts, skorts, skirts and regulation tennis shoes are required at all time. Men are required to wear a tennis shirt and shorts. Women are required to wear a tennis skirt, skort or shorts. Bare feet, sandals, running shoes, cross-trainers or other aggressive-soled shoes are not permitted for play at any time.

Fitness Center Dress Code

Proper exercise footwear is closed-toe rubber soled shoes and is required at all times. No street shoes, boots, aqua shoes or golf shoes are allowed. Shirts must be worn at all times. No bathing suit or blue jeans may be worn. Please do not sit in Bogey's in your fitness attire. If you are going to Bogey's before or after working out, change into the appropriate clubhouse attire.



GRANDEZZA TENNIS COURT RULES

Grandezza's tennis includes six lighted, Har-Tru courts available for play every day from dawn until 10:00 pm. Tennis players must be a club member of Grandezza to play on any league team.

Grandezza's tennis program has weekly men's, women's, and mixed round robin play. There are a variety of competitive leagues at different levels that play throughout the year. From October until May there are many special events including club championship tournaments, pro exhibition matches, social mixers, and more. Cardio tennis is offered twice per week.

Private and semi-private lessons are offered by the Tennis Pro, David Dekeersmaker. For league members, team clinics are available. During the summer a children's program is offered. Proper tennis attire must be worn at all times. This includes proper court shoes.

If other members are waiting to play the time limit is 1 ½ hour for doubles and 1 ¼ hour for singles.

Guest fees will be charged for anyone who is not a legal owner of a residence at Grandezza or is not registered as the tenant of a property there. All children who are 24 years of age and older are considered guests regardless of whether they live with their parents. If guests want to use a court without a member present, they must play after 12:30pm unless courts are available. In order for guests to play prior to this time 50% of the people playing on that court must be members. It is the responsibility of the member to tell the Tennis Shop when they have a guest. Guest fees are as follows:

\$10.00 – Outside players \$5.00 – House Guests and Relatives \$50.00 – Weekly guest family rate \$25.00 – Weekly individual rate

No food or beverages (coolers) can be brought on club property which includes the tennis area. (This does not include water or appropriate health drinks for one's own personal consumption during play). I realize that often home teams are expected to provide food and beverages after the league matches but this must be provided by the Food and Beverage Department.


Reciprocal tennis play is only valid from May 1st thru October 31st. Check with the Tennis Shop to see what other country clubs participate.

The ball machine can be reserved and rented anytime there is a court available and the tennis pro shop is open. The fee is \$18.00 per hour. A key club membership is available to club members for unlimited use at a yearly rate of \$149.00 for a family and \$129.00 for an individual.

Grip replacements or racket restringing available at the Tennis Shop. You may also purchase tennis accessories and a new racket.

Sabal Palm: 144 coach homes & 80 garden homes which has a clubhouse & pool.


Santa Lucia: 21 single family homes. All homes are located on Amalfi Way.
