The Club is built on 630 acres east of Collier Blvd. (County Road 951), just a 15 minute drive to the gulf beaches and downtown Naples, making it quick and easy for residents to access the best that Naples has to offer. Marco Island's beaches are only a 15 minute drive. Also nearby are shopping malls, outlets, banks, hospitals and major medical centers. Located one mile from the entrance to Interstate 75, Forest Glen is just 30 minutes south of Southwest Florida International Airport and only 90 minutes west of Fort Lauderdale and the Florida East Coast.

Dining at Forest Glen

Forest Glen offers two dining outlets for members and their guests. The main dining room is located in the clubhouse and is open Monday and Friday evenings October through April. During the Summer months the main dining room is open on Tuesday and Friday evenings May through September. The other dining option offered at Forest Glen is Eagles Nest outdoor dining facility located between Hole #9 & Hole #18, next to the clubhouse. Eagles Nest is open daily for lunch beginning at 11am with the exception of Mondays from May to October and the specified dates of golf course aerification in the Summer months. Pickleball

Our new Pickleball courts are ready for play! Pickleball is one of the fastest growing sports in the world and Naples is the “Home of the US Open Pickleball Championship”. Pickleball is for all ages, is healthy exercise, fun, social, and is very much an intergenerational sport. We will be using an “open play” system utilizing a whiteboard signup.

The Club has provided paddles and balls for members which are available on the courts. Clinics for members who want to “learn how to play the game” have been organized and signup for those clinics will begin in November and will run throughout the season. Clinics will be conducted on the courts and will cover game fundamentals such as scoring, rules of play, serving and returning, basic game strategies, and real game play.

Bocce

The Club has 3 lighted bocce courts available for individual use and league play. League play is 4 nights a week November through April. Complimentary equipment is available as well as beverage service on league nights.

Tennis

Forest Glen has a very active tennis program with related social events. Residents enjoy playing on four championship Har Tru tennis courts. The courts are beautifully situated within attractive and quiet surroundings. Windscreens provide optimum playability, excellent background, and all four courts are lighted so play can continue after dark. The canopied benches offer a respite between sets.

Players at all levels enjoy the tennis experience at Forest Glen. There is an active tennis community and many residents take advantage of the format to make new friends and arrange future matches. Open play is another option. Many members and guests enjoy night time play under the lights. Those desiring lessons to further tune their game or beginners will appreciate the availability of highly experienced teaching members.
